# Parent Handbook

READ THIS HANDBOOK THOROUGHLY!

Dear Dance Students and Parents,

- The recital will be at Mansfield Senior High School! Friday May 12<sup>th</sup> @ 7pm and Saturday May 13<sup>th</sup> @ 3pm.
- Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory unless prior permission, for extreme circumstances only, has
  been given by your dance instructor. Remember, your dancer will be more confident and have a better
  experience when he or she has more practice. Please let us know of any conflicts as far in advance as
  possible. If a student does miss any mandatory rehearsals without prior permission, he/she will not
  participate in the recital.
- <u>Do not be late</u> for your call time! Be punctual, prepared, and ready to go! **Call time is the time the student is to arrive at the theatre.**
- If you have problems arriving on time, contact Richland Academy, 419-522-8224 (Option #1), or text Sarah Horrigan-Ramos at 937-508-8031 (Option #2). If you are late and have not called, we will be concerned and will be calling you.
- Information about where dancers should enter the theatre will be given prior to tech week. We will try to appropriately assign dressing room area. However, please be understanding if dressing room areas change as the week goes on. We will adapt to the needs of the performers as much as we can to make this a good experience for everyone!
- Dancers will be chaperoned at all times. The helper mom form is in the back of this packet. If you are
  not a helper mom, we will ask you not to stay anywhere backstage or in the dressing rooms. <u>There</u>
  will be no visitation at intermission on show nights.
- Do not bring valuables into the dressing room.

Flash photography and videotaping will not be permitted, as it is dangerous to those performing on stage and a distraction to audience members. A flash drive of this performance will be available for purchase. Information will be sent via email.

- If your child has special needs or medication, please let your dance instructor and your class chaperones know.
- Ticket information: Tickets will go on Sale March 31, 2023 @ 12:00pm (noon). The ticket link & information on complimentary ticket codes will be sent via email.

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#### **COSTUMES**

- Never wear costumes TO rehearsal!!!! If you arrive at the scheduled call time, there is plenty of time to get into costume at the theater.
- **Please label every item** with the dancer's name including tights, leotards, all shoes, headpieces, etc. Use a permanent marker and write directly on the tag.
- When you receive your costume, **please keep it up and away** from smaller children and pets. Cats love the net of tutus.
- **No underwear** is to be worn under tights. To see what tights are needed for your class, refer to the recital class list on page 3 of this packet.
- **Do not play in your costume**. Once you take possession of your costume, <u>you</u> are responsible for its care. They are custom made and cannot be replaced.
- Make sure all costume straps, skirts, etc. are securely attached. Check that you have all pieces and parts of your child's costume before you leave the rehearsal or show.
- Make sure all headpieces; hats, headbands, etc. are securely attached. Use plenty of bobby pins, hair pins, hairspray and hair gel. Refer to class list for hair style or check with the teacher.
- **BUN INSTRUCTIONS**: gather the hair into a tight ponytail, twist the ponytail and wrap it around into a bun. Secure it with bobby pins and/or hair pins. Place a hair net over the bun and secure it with more pins. Pull back any bangs and secure with bobby pins, hairspray and/or gel. If you have questions or need assistance with this, please let us know.

#### \*NEW SYSTEM\*

Helper Mom Forms: We are going to send helper mom sign ups via email this year so you can register online.

#### FRIDAY, April 28th - RECITAL PICTURES 4:00 - 8:00pm

- You are NOT obligated to purchase any pictures, but we ask that you come to the photo shoot so the entire
  class may be recorded for archival purposes.
- Have your **order form filled out with payment ready** when it is your class turn.
- Use one envelope per class. We will pass out picture forms in class the week prior.
- Have hair, make-up and costume ready for your first photo.
- **Do not wear your costume in the car!!** You may have tights & unders on. But please wait to put the costume on until you arrive at the academy. Seatbelts ruin costumes!
- Arrive 10-15 minutes before your scheduled picture time to make sure you have time to primp and will not miss your photo time. We WILL NOT wait for dancers who are late.
- The time listed is when the pictures will be taken.
- Dressing rooms will be assigned. Caretakers will stay in dressing rooms with dancers until called. Please don't run around the cafeteria.
- Class and individual photos will be taken. You may leave when you are finished.
- Look at the times closely; they are **NOT** every 10 minutes. We left a bit more time for some of the larger classes. Hopefully this will help us stay more realistically on-time. Thank you.

## **TECHNICAL REHEARSALS**

The week before the show @ Mansfield Senior High School

\* No men are allowed in or near the dressing rooms during the entire week \* If a male guardian is in charge of dancer, please check in backstage and we will either have your student sit with you in the auditorium or take him/her to the dance group with the other helper moms

Parents may sit in the audience for technical and dress rehearsals with their dancer and class. Please attend to other children who may be with you. Children will not be allowed to run throughout the theatre and will be directed to the lobby if found unattended. At no time is flash photography allowed! Always feed your dancer before they come and provide non messy snacks and water bottles. No colored liquids ie: Gatorade or juice

Please be considerate and clean up your trash and space before you leave.

- Call 4:00 ALL of ACT I dancers
  - 4:20 We will lead dancers into the auditorium in order of the rehearsal to sit until it's time to dance. helper moms will stay with the class in case dancers need a restroom break
  - 4:30 Begin tech for Act I Run dances in order of the show

The purpose of these rehearsals is to set the lighting design, color, brightness, and all cues. You will be asked to go to different parts of your dance and stand while we adjust the lights. You may be asked to dance your piece to the music. Please be quiet and listen carefully to directions. You may **leave after your last dance** and after you have checked out with your helper mom.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Please bring your costumes so we can work on lights. Come prepared to dance & wear layers so you can stay warm while you're waiting. This rehearsal is for spacing dancers & lights.

<sup>\*</sup>Dancers may leave when they have rehearsed all of their numbers. Please check out with the helper mom's

Run 5:30 Curtain (we will run the bow first and then the performance IN ORDER. Dancers may leave when they finish running all of their pieces.)

Feed your dancer before they come! Dancers must be in full costume for Monday, and Wednesday with proper hairstyle; no make-up necessary. Thursday is a Dress Rehearsal with proper hairstyle AND make up. (You may leave after your last dance and you check out with your chaperone.)

#### **Theatre Etiquette:**

#### **DANCER TIPS**

- Food and beverages (except water) should not to be consumed while a dancer is in costume. No gum or candy. Eat before putting costume on
- Please eat a meal or snack before coming to the theatre.
- Dancers may each bring one small bag with water and a non messy snack. Please label the bag.
- If you'd like to bring a snack for the entire class to share, please fill out the helper mom form.
- No jewelry. This includes technical rehearsal, dress rehearsal, performances and photo day. No watches, bracelets, rings, beads or chains. Stud earrings are allowed.

<sup>\*</sup>No Flash Photography: This is dangerous for the dancers and distracting for other audience members.

<sup>\*</sup>No Video cameras are to be set up in the theatre. Information on purchasing a recorded flash drive of this performance will be shared via email.

<sup>\*</sup>Cell phones are to be turned off.



- One **female** person is allowed to pick up dancers from the dressing room. To eliminate congestion, all other family and friends please stay in the lobby to wait for the dancers; this will help control the flow of people.

#### Dear Parents,
