PAYMENT INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Please note: A registration deposit or the first monthly payment is REQUIRED at time of registration to secure class enrollment. Payment may be made online by electronic invoice or by calling 419.522.8224.

How to Make First Payment:

- Payment will be processed by phone, in-person, or online depending on the payment option selected during registration process, AUTO PAY, SELF PAY, OR FULL PAY.
- The first payment is NOT processed at the time of online registration.

Payment Options:

- **Payment In-Full** (\$5/month processing fee waived). Must contact the Front Desk to make a payment in-full or pay through electronic invoicing.
- **Auto-Pay Monthly** Payments (5% convenience fee included in total tuition). RAA PROCESSES THIS PAYMENT ON DUE DATE USING THE PAYMENT METHOD ON FILE; THE FRONT DESK WILL CONTACT YOU TO CONFIRM THE CREDIT CARD ON FILE FOR AUTOPAY.
- **Self-Pay Monthly** (\$5/month included in total tuition amount). You contact the Front Desk and make the payment or pay through electronic invoicing.
- Payments accepted by Credit Card, Cash and Check can be processed by phone, in person, and online by electronic invoice.

When Payments Are Due:

- All payments must be received **on or before the due date**.
- Fall 2026 Payment Due Dates: Aug. 31, Oct. 5, Nov. 2, and Dec. 7

Fees:

- Students will be charged a \$10 music materials fee per semester when applicable.
- **Tuition in-full prices include materials fees when applicable to music, art, and theatre classes.**
- Dance Costume and Recital Fees are due December 12.
- Creative Movement Costume Fee is due October 17.
- Students participating in 4 or more weeks of scheduled lessons or classes are responsible for a one-time yearly, non-refundable \$40 individual/\$100 family registration fee. This fee is chargeable from Aug. 3, 2026 to April 17, 2027.

Late Payments/Delinquent Accounts:

- **Tuition for the previous session must be paid-in-full before a student may register for the next session.**
- All late payments will be assessed a \$15 fee.
- Returned checks are subject to a \$30 fee plus bank charges.

Richland Academy reserves the right to cancel a class with insufficient enrollment. You will be notified and may transfer to another class or receive a full refund. Your refund check will be mailed approximately 30 days after notification.

Richland Academy of the Arts receives the right to suspend or cancel a student's instruction and performance participation for failure to pay tuition and fees.
